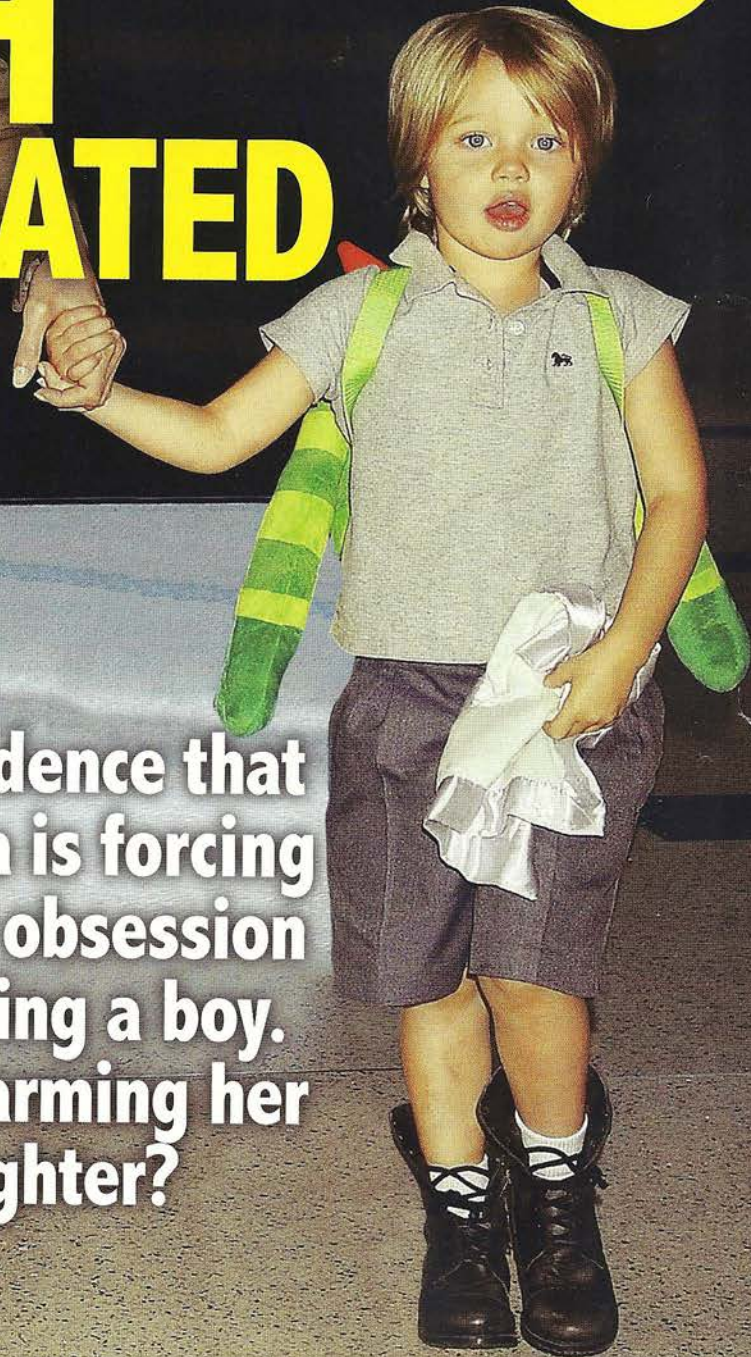

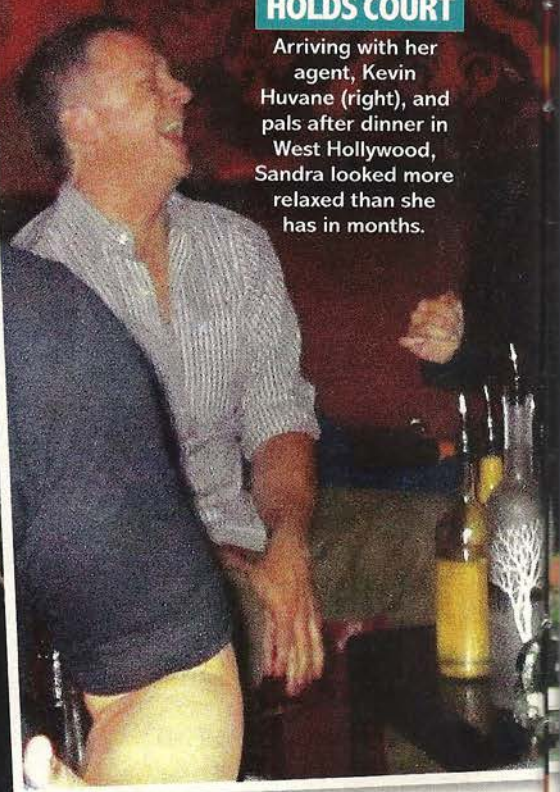

"They had the best table in the club, right in the heart of things, and they looked like they were really having fun," an Abbey waiter named Alessio tells *Life & Style*. Even if she wasn't exactly on the prowl, there was plenty of eye candy on display, as buff bartenders paraded around in nothing more than revealing briefs. "She stayed

for over three hours and had a really great time," adds an insider. "She got up and danced when the old-school '80s hip-hop she requested from the DJ came on."
